



# JUNIOR FIRE SAFETY POLICY

It is a mandatory requirement of working at LanguageUK that all staff members need to be fully conversant with this policy and any failure to observe this policy may result in disciplinary action. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR FIRE SAFETY** 

#### **Overall Responsibility:**

Overall and final responsibility for health and safety including FIRE SAFETY at the Abbey School is **Safety Representative** 

The Health & Safety Representative for these premises where LanguageUK is situated is the Head of juniors for LanguageUK.

Fire Drills will be notified to all students and leaders by a LanguageUK member of staff

## Procedure in the event of a fire

In the event of fire, the fire alarm must be sounded, and the fire brigade called.



The premises must be evacuated as quickly as possible.

Leave building IMMEDIATELY. Don't collect bags.

Staff members in charge of students are responsible for escorting the students off the premises. Once safely outside the staff member in charge of each group is responsible for checking the

register to ensure that all students are safe.





The staff members and leaders must report their findings to Head of Juniors for LanguageUK. They will in turn inform the Abbey School/LanguageUK Canterbury that all students are present.

You may experience a fire drill this is a method of practicing how a building would be evacuated in the event of a fire or other emergencies. In most cases, the building's existing fire alarm system is activated, and the building is evacuated as if the emergency had occurred. You will be told by a member of LanguageUK staff when this will occur.
